

## Biography

I am Shayan Karami, Ph.D. in History of Iran after Islam from Payame Noor University of Tehran. I am a teacher of history. My field of study is historical theorizing, social history, cultural history, history of gender, historical sociology, conceptual history, and political economy.

My recent studies focused on agriculture, animal husbandry and land ownership in western Iran, from the Qajar period to the end of the Pahlavi, based on thousands of documents.

The results of these studies are presented in the form of scientific-research papers such as: "The emergence of women's masters in western Iran", "Land reform and the issue of expropriation of female owners", "The consequences of modernizing the traditional irrigation system in western Iran," and so on. I first introduced the concept of "female lords" to Iran. This is the first time the phenomenon of "rent" from the field of political economy in the field of history I examined. I presented the theory of "state rendering" in the article "The Consequences of Land and Water Distribution in Social-Political Construction of Iran."
